
1. Megalodon – This is the largest prehistoric shark and it is now extinct. This shark is only known from the fossil records and has been estimated to be around 55-60 feet long...much larger than the Great White Sharks of today. The largest tooth ever found from a Megalodon was 7 ¼ inches big!



2. **Great White Shark** – These modern day sharks are the largest predatory fish on Earth today. They can grow between 15 and 20 feet long and live up to 70 years old. They can have up to 300 teeth in their mouths & one tooth can get up to 3 inches!



3. **Mako Shark** – The Mako shark is the fastest swimming shark and they live all over the world. They average about 6 to 9 feet long and their teeth be around 2 inches.



- 4. **Tiger Shark** This shark is the  $4^{th}$  largest shark in the world. They like warmer waters and like to swim alone. They average about 12 feet long and with  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch teeth!
- 5. **Hammerhead Shark** God designed a unique head for this shark to help it survive in the ocean. They can grow up to 13 feet long and weigh as much as a piano! They have teeth around 1 inch in size.
